As we wrap up another exciting year at the Campbell River Art Gallery, we're already thinking ahead to the whirlwind of *six* new exhibitions in 2021. Have you already started thinking about what the future holds?

To celebrate our plans, hopes, and dreams for the new year, we're going to paint snowflake ornaments with scenes entirely from our imaginations - not of what is right now, but of what we most want to see next year.



This year, winter celebrations will be very different for us all. So our vision for the future is being able to spend time with far away family members once again.

### You will need:

- 1x [Super Saturday Art Kit](#) from CRAG
- 1x Paintbrush
- 1x Cup or Bowl of Water
- Optional: Pencil, Markers

## Steps:

1. **Who's your pal-ette?** Your kit includes three primary colours (red, blue, and yellow) plus white and black. With just these five paints, you can create any colour you want just by blending specific combinations together. Add a tiny bit of each colour until you get the blend you want.



*Don't forget to rinse your brush really well between colours!*



2. **Colour your world!** You can start by sketching out your design onto the snowflake with a pencil, or you can make it up as you go using your imagination. We started by painting the background first and then sketching the details. We painted the same picture on both sides of the snowflake, but you can absolutely paint two different pictures!



*If you don't like the messiness of painting, you can use markers from home to draw your picture instead!*

## Steps:

3. **Hang tight!** Thread the wire hook through the hole by pressing gently until it pokes through. Pinch the end nearest the snowflake closed to secure it. Your snowflake is now ready to display!



4. **Share your creation with the world!** Step back and admire your finished work. Why not snap a photo to show friends and family what you've made?
